

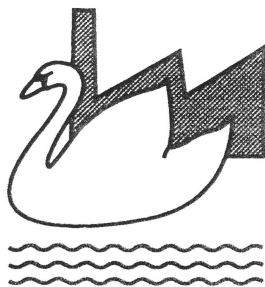

Radioactive Substances Act, 1960

CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION UNDER SECTION 1

1. This is to certify that [REDACTED] Flecc [REDACTED] (hereinafter called "the user") is registered under section 1 of the Radioactive Substances Act 1960 in respect of the user's premises at [REDACTED], Croydon, Surrey (hereinafter called "the premises") and in respect of the keeping and use thereon, on and from 15 February, 1973, of radioactive material falling within paragraph 2 below, subject to the conditions specified in paragraph 3.
2. This Certificate relates to -
 - a. anti-static devices which are radioactive material solely because they contain polonium 210 (hereinafter called "registered sources"); and
 - b. articles each of which is radioactive material solely because it incorporates a registered source or registered sources.
3. The conditions are -
 - a. that in all the registered sources (excluding those which may reasonably be required to be kept for the purpose of replacing waste sources) on the premises at any one time, the sum total of millicuries of polonium 210 does not exceed [REDACTED]
 - b. that registered sources kept on the premises for the purpose of replacing waste sources are not kept thereon for that purpose for longer than one week;
 - c. that the registered sources are so kept and used as to avoid, so far as practicable, any damage to them;
 - d. that no registered source is mutilated;
 - e. that no material (whether radioactive or not) forming part of a registered source is removed from that source;
 - f. that all necessary measures are taken to prevent any person having access to registered sources without the authority of the user;
 - g. that, when not in use or affixed to machinery in which they are used, the registered sources are kept in a container or a locked store which -
 - i. is so designed and constructed that every registered source in it is reasonably protected from damage from fire; and
 - ii. contains nothing explosive or readily inflammable;




